## Fire Watch Guidelines

<b>Effective Date:</b>	
Issued By:	

A fire watch shall be posted where there are delays in restoring fire protection systems to service for more than 4 hours.

## LEGAL AUTHORITY AND APPLICABLE CODES

International Fire Code 2018 (Section 901.7)

Where a required fire protection system is out of service, the fire department and the fire code official shall be notified immediately and, where required by the fire code official, the building shall either be evacuated or an approved fire watch shall be provided for all occupants left unprotected by the shut down until the fire protection system has been returned to service.

Where utilized, fire watches shall be provided with at least one approved means for notification of the fire department and their only duty shall be to perform constant patrols of the protected premises and keep watch for fires.

### **REQUIRING A FIRE WATCH**

- A. A fire watch is required any time a fire protection system is placed out of service in accordance with 2018 IFC as follows:
- B. Buildings where there are **occupants**, a fire watch to be posted as follows:
  - 1. Post "WARNING" signs on exterior entry doors.
  - 2. Sign Fire Watch Acknowledgement form
  - 3. The person in charge should be instructed to notify all employees/tenants of the situation.
  - 4. Employees can act as a fire watch while they are working. No fire watch is required when the building is not occupied.

#### **DUTIES OF THE FIRE WATCH**

- A. The following are minimum requirements for fire watch personnel:
  - a. They shall have no other duties, and they shall continuously patrol the structure(s) looking for fire and/or hazardous conditions.
  - b. Know evacuation procedures for the structure
  - c. In the event of an emergency, call 911, alert the occupants and start evacuation procedures immediately.
  - d. Have a functioning flashlight.
  - e. Know how to activate the building fire alarm system and/or the building public address system.
  - f. Know how to operate a fire extinguisher and shall know the location of fire extinguishers in or around the structure.
- B. The following are guidelines for determining how many personnel are needed for a fire watch:
  - a. Take into consideration the size of the complex (distance between buildings). Buildings spaced far apart will require more personnel. Personnel shall walk through all portions and inspect all sides of the building. The fire watch personnel shall be able to view all areas under the fire watch in less than 10 minutes.
  - b. Multiple story structures = one person for every four floors. The fire watch shall be able be to view all areas under the fire watch in less than 20 minutes.

#### **CANCELLING A FIRE WATCH**

- A. Any required fire watch may be cancelled provided the following conditions are met:
  - a. Documentation is received from a fire sprinkler or fire alarm contractor confirming that the system is **repaired**, **in service**, and **fully operational**; **OR** an inspection by the Fire Inspection personnel confirms the operational status of the affected fire protection system.
- B. The Fire Inspectors Office must be notified in writing by e-mailing <a href="mailto:jadamson@tifton.net">jadamson@tifton.net</a>; tatkinson@tifton.net; or kdaughtry@tifton.net
- C. Fire Inspection personnel shall conduct follow-up inspections on all fire watches to confirm that the fire protection system in question has indeed been **repaired**, is **in service**, and is **fully operational**.
