Upon approval of the application permit; owner/applicant agree as follows:

- 1. The facilities covered hereby shall be installed in accordance with the attached plan, drawings and specifications [attached hereto as Exhibit A] the City of Tifton's Code of Ordinances, Land Development Code and the City of Tifton's approval process. In the event any changes or modifications of the design and/or plan are made during the construction or installation of the facilities, the applicant/owner shall provide to the City of Tifton an "as built" drawing and plan depicting the changes and/or modifications and the location of the facilities.
- 2. In the event of emergency necessitated by flood, storm, natural disaster or Act of God, requiring the City of Tifton to make repairs to its facilities, the applicant/owner of the facilities shall be notified in accordance with The Georgia Utility Facility Protection Act.
- 3. The City shall not be responsible or liable for any injury or damage the facilities in the event the facilities are not located as depicted on the approved drawings, specifications or "as built' modifications.
- 4. The City of Tifton shall not be liable for any costs or expense incurred for the relocation

of said facilities which may be necessitated by the improvement of said street/ROW.

- 5. No utilities are to be installed above existing utilities and drainage structures.
- 6. Any damage to existing utilities and drainage structures found to be caused by the owner/applicant's installation shall be repaired by the City of Tifton at the applicant/owner's expense.
- 7. The City of Tifton must be given 48 hours' notice before work is to begin. All utility installation in the right-of-way must maintain a minimum of 30" of cover.
- 8. Areas disturbed by installation shall be fully restored to include grading to match existing and revegetated (ROW). Any asphalt cuts shall be repaired in accordance with the standards and specifications attached as Exhibit B. The owner/applicant shall be responsible for any road damage resulting from their construction for one year after installation of the facilities. All areas must be free of any construction debris upon completion.
- 9. This document is to be strictly construed and no other work other than specifically described herein and the attached documents shall be authorized other than normal maintenance and repair.
